So, please join us & ask the questions you want answers to . . . Sewers, National Grid gas connections, and any other questions you think might enhance the quality of life in our community.

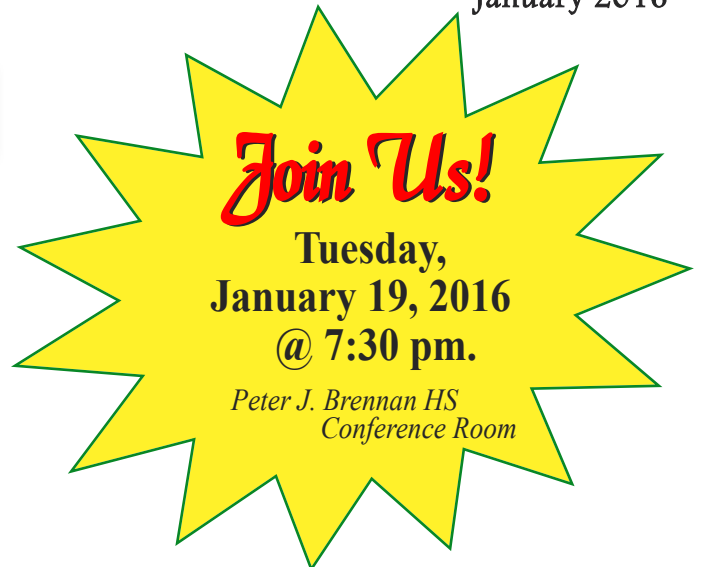
Again, I ask those of you who are not members of the Civic family, to join us and become involved with issues in your community.
